### CA Scurry slalom: Objective: points challenge

Each cone is worth 1 point. There are 27 points possible (20 points for VSEs\*). The cones are set in three lines—Line 1 is 7 cones, Line 2 is 9 cones and Line 3 is 11 cones. In the event of a clear round, a second go round is timed. A ball down ends that round, the clock stops, and the time is recorded to use as a tie-breaker. The number of cones cleared may be used as an alternative or secondary tie-breaker consideration. \*Line 1 would be omitted and VSEs cross the start line in the opposite direction of other divisions but finish in the same direction.

<u>Team Cones:</u> A team of two carriages or a team of one carriage and one rider negotiate parts of the cones course, alternately.

On a ten cone course, the first turnout would drive, in order, cones #1-#5. In the meantime the second turnout (or rider) is in the arena ready to drive cones #6-#10 once the first turnout clears cone #5. **However**, if the first turnout dislodges a ball, that turnout is done and the second turnout must start at the cone where the ball was dislodged and continue through the cones numerically. The clock stops once the second turnout/rider crosses the finish line and a 3 second time penalty is given for each ball dislodged by the second team member. For riders, the distance between cones is narrowed.
